

BPA Action Week: Call Governor Patrick Today!

We have a big opportunity in Massachusetts to protect children from BPA, a toxic chemical linked to hyperactivity, impaired learning and other developmental issues, and your voice needs to be heard!

Please call Governor Patrick today and ask him to phase-out BPA products for which there are safer alternatives. He has proposed to phase BPA out baby bottles and cups, but to protect child health the state should also phase BPA out of infant formula and baby food packaging as well as reusable beverage and food containers. Connecticut has taken action to protect its citizens; we should have the same safer products in Massachusetts.

- Tell them your name and where you live
- Say "Thank you for protecting our health by calling for a phase-out of BPA products. Don't just stop at baby bottles and cups, please include infant formula, cans and food and beverage containers as well."
